**Important information for IN-PERSON Attendees (online, see below)**

**KREIA does NOT proofread the information you submit on your registration form. Check your nametag. That information is what we received and what will be on your continuing education transcript. If it's wrong, please contact a KREIA Board of Directors member to have it corrected before the transcripts are issued.**

To comply with the continuing education rules of the Kentucky Board of Home Inspectors, the Kentucky Real Estate Inspectors Association (KREIA) asks that you follow the rules below to receive continuing education credit for the classes you attend and improve the classroom atmosphere.

To provide a learning environment we require the following:

- **Silence or turn off your cell phones.**
- **Refrain from cross conversations with other students. We are there to listen and interact with the instructor.**
- **Reading materials other than that provided by KREIA or the instructor are not allowed in the classroom.**
- **Disruptive and inappropriate behavior will result in the inspectors involved being asked to leave with no credit for that class.**

There will be a 10-minute break after each 60-minute block of instruction.

Inspectors entering the classroom more than 10-minutes late from the start of class or return from lunch or breaks **will not receive credit for that class.**
